First Section (Personal Information):

Personal info:

Name, Phone Number, Email, (Reachable at - all email and phones you want them to try to get ahold of you) plus birthday and apple communications

Password & Security:

Password, 2FA, Trusted Phone #'s, Verification code, Security Keys (HW), Account Recovery (a person to help recover your data), Legacy contact when you die, Auto Verification (avoids CAPTCHAs), Apps using Apple ID to hide your email.

Payment & Shipping:

Which card is being used by your AppleID to buy things, Apple Cash (Like Venmo) & Apple Card balance

iPhone Subscriptions:

All your active subscriptions, Inactive (expired on Mac), along with sharing with family and getting renewal receipts (ON!!!)

Second Section (iCloud, Media.., Family Sharing):

iCloud:

iCloud storage purchased and used with Account Storage allowing you to increase Optimize ON!!
