- 1. Call to order John Acquavella called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

- 3. Short topic Bookmarks Steven Ancowitz presented using bookmarks on Safari. He showed how to add a bookmark in Safari on a MacBook. Drag and drop or use Add Bookmark from Safari Menu. Add bookmarks to Favorites if you use them frequently; if not used frequently, just create a bookmark. Organize bookmarks/favorites in order of most important or frequently used. Create a folder in Favorites to hold multiple websites. Steven demonstrated many ways to organize bookmarks, folders and favorites to make them easier to locate when needed. Organize Favorites Menu bar and Bookmarks page for ultimate organization. He explained the difference between Start Page and Favorites Page in Safari.

Long topic HomePod and AirPods Deborah Neff & Craig Wright presented the HomePod mini, and the 2nd generation HomePod which was just released with upgraded features at the original price of \$299. Home Pod Minis are for indoor use. Priced at \$99, they can be used as speakers with Apple TV, although they do not support Dolby Atmos or Dolby Surround 7.1. They described how to

setup HomePod Mini - fairly seamless though must be done through HomeKit on iPhone or iPad. Described what Siri can do with HomePods: Play music, weather, temp, news and ambient sound. Can be used as intercom with multiple speakers. Turn on voice recognition to ask Siri to do things. A video was shown on how to setup Apple TV 4K with HomePods or HomePod Minis. Use ARC setting on TV with Apple TV. New features are included with 2nd generation HomePod which was recently released and is available for order. All communication is encrypted on Home Pods. Craig and Deborah described the different models of Air Pods: basic, Pro and Max. Pairing Air Pods with different devices using Bluetooth is fairly straightforward. The Pro and Max models have noise cancelling features.
