- 1. Edit/undo to quickly undo an action or some typing. Works in almost any program.
- 2. Use reader view in Safari on Mac. Makes it easier to read an article while eliminating ads, popups, etc.
- 3. Add or change wallpaper on your desktop.
- 4. Use launchpad to open an app not in the dock
- 5. Use Mission Control to view apps that are running in current window
- 6. Resize your dock
- 7. Create the degree ° symbol. Hold the Shift-Option-8 keys. If you forget that key combination, type Fn E key to bring up list of symbols.
- 8. Check the percentage of battery on Bluetooth devices
